Port Blair

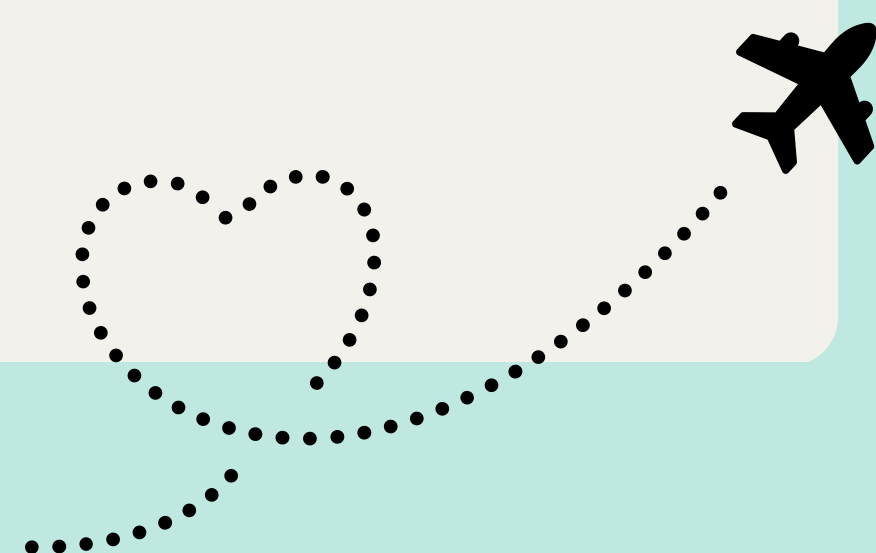
